### Membership Categories:

- REGULAR MEMBERSHIP** is comprised of suburban Chicago commercial buildings or properties represented by individuals who are owners, managers, investors, developers, leasing or marketing representatives, asset managers and others who earn their primary livelihood from associated disciplines located within the boundaries of the Association.
